First Communion, The Day of Pentecost May 23, 2010

The Day of Pentecost, which is May 23rd this year, has been designated as the time when Christ Church will celebrate first Holy Communion for those children who are interested, whether it was actually the 'first' time or not.

Fr. Wrede will give a short session to offer instruction as to what communion is according to scripture and the church, along with practicing altar rail etiquette some time during the week before the 'big day', and on the Pentecost, these children will receive communion first, together at the altar rail, and participate in the service in other ways.

Those parents who are interested in having their children receive instruction for their first Holy Communion are asked to contact the church school teachers or the parish offices and to provide possible dates and times that the child is available for the class.
